Annual General Meeting

The Friends of Hyde Park Cemetery held their AGM on Tuesday 18 November at Club 39 from 7pm

As well as formal business, the Friends were treated to a talk by Symeon Waller entitled WHAT LIES BENEATH - THE OPENING OF THE COOKE FAMILY VAULT.

This told the fascinating story about finding and opening of the long lost vault belonging to the baronetcy of Wheatley and Arksey whose surname is Cooke.

Originally, the belief was that a very grand tomb bearing the name Cooke, in Hyde Park Cemetery, was linked to the same family. However, research found that there was no connection as this family hailed from Fishlake.

The vault was actually found to be in the north transept of Arksey Parish Church. After much excavation, steps were discovered leading down to a vault that contained the remains of 10 members of the Cooke family dating back hundreds of years and last opened when the 8th Baronet - Sir William Bryan-Cooke was interred in 1851.


Halloween Walk

Patrick Stirling Locomotive Superintendent Great Northern Railway

He was Locomotive Superintendent for the Great Northern Railway from 1866 to 1895 and well respected throughout the railway world. He designed the famous "Stirling single" built at Doncaster works that hauled the *Flying Scotsman* express in the Victorian era.
